San Elijo Hills Homeowners Association, Inc. Instructions for Submission of a Request for Architectural Improvement

This HOA is in Solana Beach. If you live in San Marcos, do not use this form!

The HOA's goal in requiring you to submit this form is to help ensure that home improvement projects add value to the homes within our community while retaining the unique character of our residential neighborhood. Our Protective Covenants and Restrictions (PC&Rs) allow owners considerable flexibility in updating their homes with the latest designs and material technologies, while promoting a degree of consistency with the overall design context of our community.

According to the PC&Rs, nothing may be erected, placed or planted exterior to any dwelling, nor may any excavation or demolition commence without the prior written approval of the Architectural Committee using this request form, with the following exceptions: (1) Maintaining the appearance of existing structures and landscaping, including like-with-like replacement and repainting in the same color scheme, (2) Painting any exterior surface white, beige, cream, taupe, light sage, light peach, pale yellow, wheat, light brown, or light gray, (3) Painting exterior trim, fascia, window casings, door, or fences patina green, forest green, evergreen, olive, medium brown, or dark brown, (4) Painting fences black, or (5) Painting the front door any color. For all other exterior modifications, you must submit this request form with a description of the **nature**, **size**, **height**, **color**, **and location** of all proposed improvements. Guidelines to help you provide an adequate description are given below for a few of the most common types of projects.

Our community voted in June 2023 that your most-affected neighbors must sign this form, either digitally or with ink. They are only confirming that they were notified – their approval is not required. Notifying them before you undertake a project helps prevent anxiety that can arise when they see construction start and don't know where it's heading. A further important benefit of these notifications is that they encourage neighbors to meet who might not otherwise.

1. Landscaping/Fencing/ Hardscapes

- Include a site plan showing proposed modifications to plantings, hardscape, water features, and permanent outdoor structures. Note plant descriptions, quantity, and size. Note the style, color, and height of fencing, walls, and outdoor structures. A sample site plan is available under the Documents tab on the HOA website.
- Provide an unambiguous description (specifications, photos, or website links) for each proposed material used for fencing, walls, outdoor structures, and hardscape. For outdoor structures, show elevations with dimensions.

2. Alterations, Remodels and Additions

- Include a schematic site plan to scale showing all structural modifications. If applicable, show the location of the top/toe of the slope and the distance of structural improvements from the top/toe of the slope.
- Include a schematic floor plan to scale showing all changes and improvements, highlighting alterations.
- Include schematic elevations to scale showing all changes and improvements, highlighting alterations.
- Include an unambiguous description for materials and products (specification, photos, or website links). Note any exterior color changes with specifications (brand a color name), samples, or photos.

3. **Painting**

Include all changes to the existing exterior paint colors on the house, uninhabited structures, or fencing. Indicate paint locations and provide color specifications or photos. This form is not required if repainting to match existing colors or for colors on the pre-approved list given near the top of this page.

4. Solar

Include an overlay showing the number and location of solar panels on the roof. To the extent consistent with California Civil Code Section 714, solar panels must be mounted parallel to and not more than 6 inches above the roof, and all readily visible rails and electrical conduit must be painted to match their surroundings.
